Congratulations on your purchase of the IASUS MOBILE AMP.



The MOBILE AMP is designed to compensate for the low output volumes, which is preset with so many of today's mobile media devices. The IASUS MOBILE AMP will also help conserve the device's power, thereby extending the operation time

Using your MOBILE AMP

Before using the IASUS MOBILE AMP, you must charge the battery:

- Ensure that the IASUS MOBILE AMP is OFF (A)
- Connect the lead from the charger (G) to the jack on the amp (D)
- Connect the charger cord (H) to a AC wall socket
- The red LED on the charger will be lit while charging.
- The LED will turn green when the charging is complete
- Disconnect the MOBILE AMP from the charger.

Once the battery is charged, the MOBILE AMP is almost ready for use.

- Plug your headphones into the MOBILE AMP at (C)
- Plug the MOBILE AMP into your mobile media device
- Slide the ON/OFF switch (A) from OFF to ON
- · Adjust the volume knob (B) to desired setting

Depending on the type of mobile media, the MOBILE AMP's operation life is expected to be up to 15 hours. When the volume becomes low (without changing the volume setting) or if the charge indicator (F) is no longer lit, the MOBILE AMP's battery may be low. Recharge the battery for continued use.

Use and Care

General

- For optimal performance of your IASUS MOBILE AMP, we recommend the following suggestions.
- Follow all operating guidelines and parameters of your mobile media device that you will use the MOBILE AMP with.
- Keep the MOBILE AMP dry. Precipitation, humidity and all types of liquids or moisture can contain minerals that will corrode electronic circuits.
- Do not use or store the MOBILE AMP in dusty, dirty areas.
- Do not store the MOBILE AMP in hot areas. High temperatures can shorten the life of electronic devices, damage batteries, and warp or melt certain plastics.
- Do not store the MOBILE AMP in cold areas. When the MOBILE AMP returns to its normal temperature, moisture can form inside and damage the electronics.
- The optimal storage temperature is between 15°C and 25°C (59°F and 77°F)

- Do not attempt to open the MOBILE AMP.
- Do not drop, knock, or shake the MOBILE AMP. Rough handling can break internal circuit boards and fine mechanics.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents to clean the MOBILE AMP.

Rechargeable Battery

- The full performance of a new battery is achieved only after two or three complete charge and discharge cycles.
- Unplug the charger from the electrical plug and the device when not in use.
- Do not leave the MOBILE AMP connected to a charger after it is fully charged. Overcharging may shorten its lifetime.
- Do not attempt to charge the battery by another charger other than the original charger.
- Temperature extremes can affect the ability of your battery to charge.
- Use the battery only for its intended purpose. Never use any charger or battery that is damaged.

 A device with a hot or cold battery may not work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged. Battery performance is particularly limited in temperatures well below freezing.

Caution

Do not set the volume too high. Continuous exposure to high volumes may result in hearing impairment. If you experience ringing in your ears, discontinue using the device or lower the volume.

Some headphones may not be graded to withstand the power added by the MOBILE AMP. Please check with the specifications of your headphones to ensure compatibility.

It may be illegal in some areas to operate a vehicle while using a mobile media device.

Please check your local laws before operating under such circumstances.

Troubleshooting

Problem

Solution

- Check that the ON/OFF switch is set to ON
 - Ensure plug to the mobile media device is fully inserted

- Ensure headphone plug is fully inserted
- Ensure that battery is fully charged
- Ensure your mobile media device and headphones are functional by trying them without the MOBILE AMP

- Cannot Charge Ensure that wall charger is plugged into the AC socket
 - Ensure that charger lead is plugged into the MOBILE AMP
 - Ensure that the temperature is within the operating parameters.

One Year Limited Warranty

What this warranty covers

IASUS Concepts Limited warrants that the MOBILE AMP sold by IASUS Concepts or its authorized agents are free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for one year. This warranty is only applicable to the original purchaser of the Noise Terminator, when accompanied by a dated sales document receipt and the name of the company from which it was purchased. This warranty is in lieu of and excludes all other

warranties, expressed or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness, and of any other obligation on the part of IASUS Concepts Limited.
